DESCRIPTION: Paragon RD series brick is carbon-bonded synthetic dolomite brick for steelmaking applications like ladles. The synthetic nature of the grain in the brick equates to uniformity, consistency, and high performance. The resin binder affords thermal shock resistance and high hot strength. Brick is available with graphite additions for increased modulus of elasticity.
